### **2009 Bouvier Morey St Denis "en la Rue de Vergy"**

*This honest little vineyard is sandwiched between 2 grand cru, Clos de Tart and Clos des Lambrays and yet is a fraction of the price (really)*

## ***Single-Vineyard Zins***

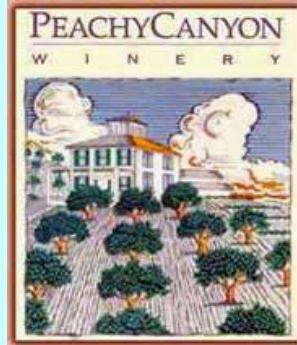
*Folks, it is still summertime out there, and you need a great Zin to go with your BBQ ribs and what-not. We were fortunate to get a great*
